

***This is the user guide with the One Hand Flute. This instrument has been made for the OHMI Trust by Flutelab of Amsterdam.***

- The OneHandFlute is a precision instrument. Other precision instruments such as a computer or a camera has a sturdy shell to protect it. This flute has not so you should be really careful with it.

So: please do not place it on a bed or chair or on the ground. Do not swing it around and do not lend it out not even for 5 minutes.

- To assemble it, start with the support stand if you are using it. Make sure all the knobs are very secure, especially the brass handle.

- To hold the flute, put your hand near the tenon. that is the part with the name "flutelab"on it.

-Have a look at the key rod that goes highest on the flute. It terminates with two little keys. The cap of the flutehead should be right over that rod (not over the keys).

- If you use the support stand, put the flute on the stand now. There is a small protrusion on the flute that fits in the support stand. It only fits one way around. The handle is away from you and the white round knob is towards you. Do tighten the white knob.

- after playing first remove the flute head. If you find it difficult to remove you can use the slot in the case.

- Dry the flute. Let the weight of the swab fall trough and then pull the swab trough. If the swab is wet, let it dry outside of the case.

-To clean the flute, rub the outside carefully with a microfibre cloth. The yellow parts inside the keys are called pads and they are really delicate. Do not rub against them.
